PARENTS PAGE: PREPARING FOR CAMP

TRAVEL & CAMPER SPENDING:

By this point, you should have completed and returned your Camper Travel Form. We must know how each child is arriving at camp. We will be sending an email home with specific bus and flight information during the first week of June that will help you prepare for the first day of camp.

Also, please make sure you've put a little money in your camper's spending account. You'll find this in your MyCampManager account on the main page under the 'View Camper Spending' heading. (It is near the bottom of your main page menu.)

FORMS:

The Activity Preference, Camper Profile, & Bunk Request Forms should all be complete at this time. Health, Insurance, and Authorization Forms should be completed by June 1st. We have marked all forms in our system as 'completed' to date. If your MyCampManager account shows missing forms, please call the office to let us know when to expect them. Please note: The Additional Options should be completed <u>only</u> by families who want Hebrew lessons.

CLOTHING AND PACKING:

By this time, all US families should have contacted Camp Trucking (<u>www.camptrucking</u>. <u>com</u> or 970.949.0690) to arrange for your child's bags to be transported to camp. All baggage must arrive to camp by June 18th for Tribal and Super Six and July 15th for Olympic Session. Camper for a Week participants should bring their luggage to camp with them. **Make sure to leave a blue or white camp shirt out to wear for to the first day of camp this summer. Campers flying to camp should wear a blue Weequahic t-shirt.**

TICK PREVENTION:

While we will ensure our campers use repellents whenever necessary, we will also be professionally treating the grounds before camp, for further peace of mind. It never hurts to go over how to self-check for ticks with your camper as well!

PERSONAL CONTACT INFORMATION & CONTACTING CAMP:

Please review your personal contact information as well as Emergency Contact information in your MyCampManager account. It is vital for us to have correct contact info.

Please do not hesitate to call us if you need any help with your MyCampManager account, forms, travel information, or anything else. Our office is open Monday to Friday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm until June 21st when we switch to 8:30am to 8:30pm. If you have a question for Cole this summer, please call camp at **570.798.2716**. Cole will not be answering his personal cell phone. Also, emails cannot be returned promptly.

Photos are uploaded twice each day (around 12:45pm and 10:30pm) into your MyCamp-Manager account. We'll organize the photos between gender and age group. In other words, if your daughter is a rising 5th grader, you'll look in the folder for Jinter Girls. (You might need to look in the groups on either side as our photographers get to know the kids over the first few days.) With so many campers, it is impossible to get each one up daily. Call us if you've not seen a picture of your camper in three days and we'll do our best to get you a few shots.
